It is great that the three PIU posts have been filled.

Below are the minutes of the discussion at MOC on May 17, 2018

Eligibility of BFTI: The Bank informed the meeting that it had completed its review of BFTI's (i) Article of association (AA) and (ii) Memorandum of Association (MA), and confirmed that BFTI is eligible to compete for contracts under the Project. Any single source contracting is subject to thresholds as per World Bank procurement rules.

Training Program: The meeting agreed that the PIU should develop a longer-term training program, based on a diagnostic of training needs for women in the four selected sub-sectors. It would be prudent to start with 1 or 2 sectors. The meeting also agreed that any ad-hoc training programs would not be an effective utilization of project resources — unless based on a diagnostic identifying such needs. MOC needs to determine if they would like to carry out the training diagnostic in-house or recruit individual consultants to do this task. BFTI informed the meeting they would be willing to provide support in the diagnostic. BFTI could also be selected as the training provider — either through competitive selection or single source selection (unique capabilities), depending on the proposed size of the contract.

Exposure visit: The Bank offered no-objection for the exposure visit on Women Entrepreneurship Development to the Netherlands and Germany. Meeting participants should include select members of the NTTFC. The meeting advised that newly selected Project Manager should be included as participant.
